## TWAIN IN ELMIRA ITINERARY

Discover the magnificent country where Mark Twain penned many of his most renowned books, including "The Adventures of Tom Sawyer" and "Adventures of Huckleberry Finn."

Discover why "The Trouble Begins" during a **Center for Mark Twain Studies** lecture at The Barn of Quarry Farm. The original site of Twain's study, Quarry Farm is the quiet refuge in the hills overlooking the Chemung River Valley where Twain and his family summered for twenty years. Be inspired as you step into Twain's study, identified by USA Today as "the number one literary attraction in America." If you are visiting during July and August, hop aboard a trolley for a guided one-hour **Trolley into Twain Country** tour.

View Twain memorabilia and photographs at The Mark Twain Exhibit in Hamilton Hall on the Elmira College campus and the **Chemung County History Museum** in downtown Elmira. Pay your respects to a true American literary legend at Elmira's **Woodlawn Cemetery**, Twain's final resting place alongside his wife and children.
